

SEAPORT VILLAGE

Climb aboard our historic ships to learn about seafaring during the Age of Sail, or walk through our seaport village to discover what life was like in a maritime community in the 19th century. See demonstrations and learn about historic crafts and trades, such as coopering, carving, printing, and blacksmithing.

PRESERVATION SHIPYARD

The Henry B. du Pont Preservation Shipyard is where traditional techniques are passed on to the next generation—right in front of your eyes! Watch as expert shipwrights restore and maintain the Museum's vast watercraft collection and other large vessels.

STAR CENTRAL

Learn the secrets of the night sky at one of the Treworgy Planetarium shows, or let the little ones climb aboard the nautical-themed playscape. The Funk Children's Museum (ages 7 and under) and Home Port (ages 8-12) offer children and families the chance to spend quality time at arts and crafts, games, and more.

MCGRAW GALLERY QUAD

Discover your own sea story through the engaging exhibitions on display in the indoor galleries located on the north end of campus.

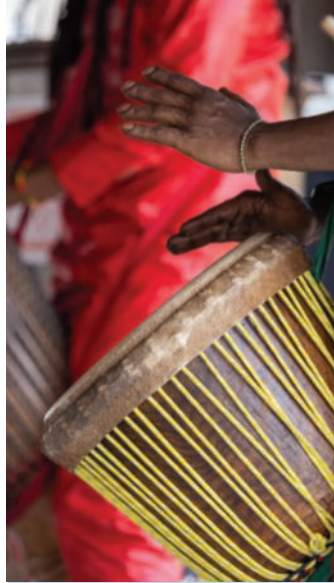
KIDS ACTIVITY ZONE

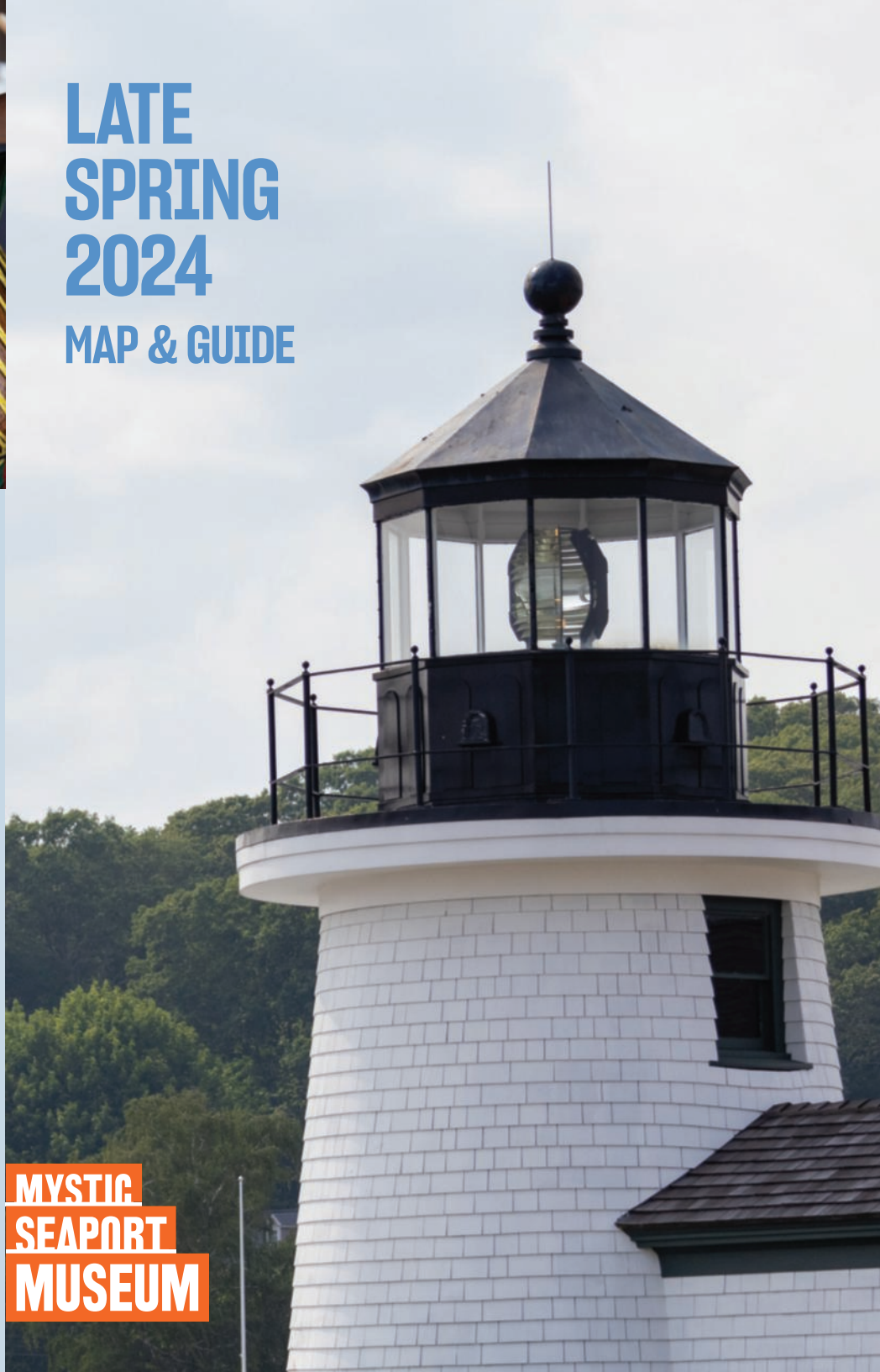

Our historic site includes uneven terrain. Please watch your step as you explore the grounds.

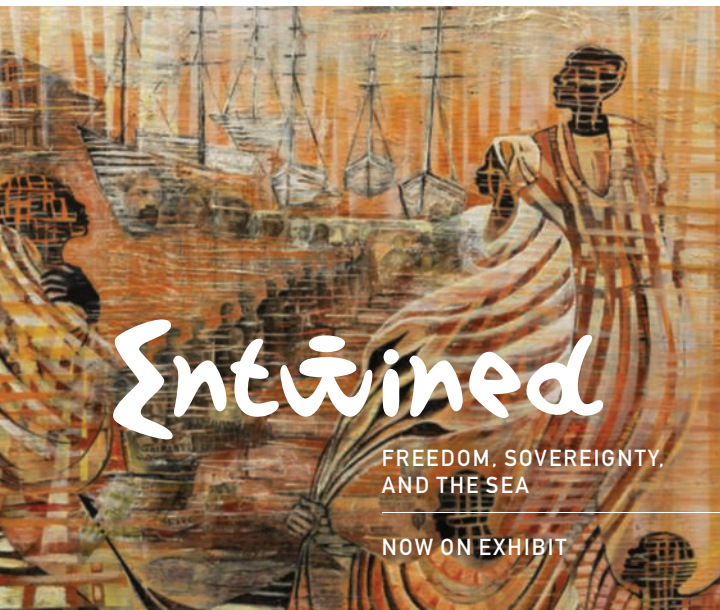
