
A MESSAGE FROM STEPHEN C. WHITE PRESIDENT AND CEO


Dear Friends,

In 2017, the Mystic Seaport Museum Board of Trustees adopted a new comprehensive strategic plan to articulate the operating



Dear Members and Friends,


This past year has been one of great achievement, as we continue to transform the visitor experience at Mystic Seaport Museum.

We are indebted to our members: some celebrating their 60th anniversary! We salute you all for your loyal support.








CONTRIBUTED REVENUE BY PURPOSE


